

Conditions for photo shoots during El Mundo Fantasia 2024

- ✓ Provided that it is in good morals and respectful to the cosplayer and other visitors, everyone is free to take pictures during El Mundo Fantasia", even if professional equipment is used.
- ✓ Before the start of shooting, it is nice if the cosplayer in question is asked for permission.
- ✓ If a cosplayer does not appreciate captured photography, the shooting should be stopped immediately.
- √ The photographers are not allowed to support thoroughfares and trails.
- ✓ Be respectful with the buildings; flora & fauna on the Mondo Verde event site.
- √ The photographer has the right to publish the photo taken without express permission, as long as there is no interest, Twilight Fantasy Productions or Mondo Verde is harmed.
- ✓ It would be great if the photographed cosplayer but also Twilight Fantasy
 Productions/Mondo Verde could request a digital version of the photo for free for their own
 non-commercial use. If this photo is shared with friends of family (Instagram, Facebook, etc.),
 it would be much appreciated if the name of the photographer was also mentioned.
- ✓ Links to online photo albums and other photo websites are very welcome and will be published on our own websites with credit. In this way, all visitors can enjoy the event and all the beautiful photos that were taken for a long time to come!

However, a photographer is not allowed:

- ✓ Offer photos before, during or after the event for a fee, in any form to anyone. Handing out tickets that go to a website with payment function.
- √ Upload photos to a website with payment function.
- √ Reserve locations on the Mondo Verde event site for photo shoots.

The above rules also apply to future video and sound recordings. These rules are subject to prior approval from Twilight Fantasy Productions. The events of Twilight Fantasy Productions (TFP) can be recorded. TFP reserves the right to without any photos events and videos taken at its events.
